Guest Speaker: Colin Stirling of Transportation outlined proposals to introduce 20MPH orders for all roads within Tayport except the main road through , which will be subject to 20 MPH in the area around the school when children are coming and going to school. Speed bumps would also be put down in Maitland St , Nelson St , Ogilvy St , Elizabeth St and Shanwell Rd South .The idea of 20MPH limits were generally welcomed, though considerable reservations regarding the speed bumps were expressed . Points were made regarding safety , vibration and noise in adjacent houses and their usefulness . An extended 20MPH zone to cover the Nursery school was suggested , also lights and signs before fitting speed bumps . After a lively discussion , letters from local residents were given to Mr Stirling .
