Presentation: Mr J Thomson - Kingdom Housing and Campbell Reid – Architect , presented plans for 56 houses at Scotsraig Drive. Some will be for rent and cannot be sold , the remainder will be for share ownership of 51 to 80% with Kingdom Housing retaining 20% Golden share . Questions asked about number of houses , design , parking provision and lack of pedestrian access by footpath . Start of building hoped for January 2007 . Objection to be raised by letter to Kingdom Housing , copied to Fife Council on High Density Housing setting a precedent for the future and the lack of pedestrian access on this site .
