<p>Fife Councillors Report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Castle Road and Castle Terrace will not become one way . 2. Meeting with Transportation on Friday 8th to consider traffic calming at School. 3. Newport Road B946 will be single carriageway with traffic lights control from 25th September to 13th October and completely closed from 16th to 29th October . 4. Fencing will not be erected around play equipment at East Common . 5. The proposed garden and associated works estimated cost £45,000 . 6. The Water Treatment Plant works will not be completed until mid October . Concern was raised at limited amount of parking and no footpath . 7. Fife Council planning to sell ground at Ogilvy Place for housing . It was pointed out that previous houses on the site had to be demolished due to subsidence . 8.
