Parking outside 29 Queen Street causing difficulty for buses and lorries exiting Elizabeth Street and turning left . 8. Cemetery extension – not yet needed . 9. Suggested rumble strips be used instead of humps for traffic calming . 10. Touring vans using Car Park at East Common due to lack of facilities within Caravan park .
