<p>Fife Council and General Correspondence:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Community Council Seminar on 10th February was cancelled . 2. No funding in present budget for footpath at Scotsraig Drive .It could be continued from the Bus Stop around the corner and up the North side . Colin Gilbert may have access to some money from the Locality Budget .It would seem that the land between the top of Scotsraig Drive and Spearhill Road is owned by Dundee . 3. The Scottish Executive is prepared to extend the areas covered by any Byelaws prohibiting the consumption of Alcohol in Public Places . This will now cover the West Common and beyond to Newport . 4. Public Consultation on draft planning guidance on Wind Energy and other Renewable Technologies will be held over a 12 week period . 5. Thanks to Mr G Thomson of Mars Bank for cleaning this up 3. Braid Road is to be closed from 9th to 23rd April for Gas pipe work . There have been no Public Notices about the work on Albert Street and Braid Road . 4. Commonty Road to have some repair work done , although owned by Dundee Council , Fife Council will be doing the work . 5. Colin Stirling – Transportation , provided answers to a list of questions raised previously about the Speed Cushions . The 20mph area may be extended to include the Tennis Courts and Playpark .
