Kingdom Housing withdrawal and re-submission for consent to build 56 houses north of Scotsraig Drive . <p>Fife Councillors Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Replies to previous questions received 2. Concern about speeding on Dalgleish Street by cuclists coming downhill from Cycle Path .Suggest alternative route via Marine Parade. 3. Serpentine Car Park requires cleaning up . 4. People using NHS24 can request to be seen at Wallacetown Health Centre in Dundee instead of St Andrews 5. Land at Ogilvy Place to auctioned by Fife Council on 20th June 6. Gregory Hall to be revamped with better disabled access and toilets 7. Request to purchase part of the Primary School playground to go with the clinic for access to Rose Street . Suggested refusal . 8. The school will be taking in 5 disabled childrennext term and a reserved parking place is required in Rose Street for vehicle . No objection 9. Tayport Caravan Park seeking planning permission to remove bund , which has been granted . Concerns raised about contents which could include asbestos . All planting must be maintained for 5 years . 10. Tayport Ferryport on Craig Community Council Constitution . It is necessary to amend our quorum from 50% + 1 to a fixed number . It was proposed and agreed the new quorum would be 6 . 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. "No motorcycles" sign at West Lights on the wrong side of the Cycle Path 2. Notice claiming exclusive Residents Parking at West Lights needs to be removed 3. Garden rubbish being dumped in old quarry at West Lights 4. Footpath from Burnside corner to Law Cottage should be reinstated .On B945 5. Old Clydesdale Bank building being offered for sale with planning permission for 6 flats , which it does not have 6. Suggest that bus shelters be moved towards the front end of bus bays so that buses can pull right into the bay 7. Several Road Signs are covered by tree growth in Queen Street , Albert Street and at Tay Road Bridge access 8. Groth needing cut back from path between Scotsraig Drive and Downiemount 9. Ivy needing cut back from steps at top of Reform Street 10. Dead tree within the grounds of The Cottage overhanging Dougall Street could be dangerous
