The local office has been closed due to staff shortages 3. A roundel at Scott Crescent has been rebuilt 4. The ramp outside of Gregory Hall has been completed . Concern about proximity of steps at side door too close to doorway and also bottom step sticks out beyond hand rail .Interior work to be done later . 5. Tankers from Waste Water treatment Works are coming through Tayport contrary to planning undertaking 6. Complaint about poor appearance of area surrounding WWtW . 7. Bushes overgrown in Whitenhill and at steps in Reform Street 8. Pot holes in Car Park on sea front and at East Common off Mill Lane 9. Seat at West Common by swings missing spar 10. Complaints about Speed humps to be put in writing to Councillor M Taylor
