What are present opening times and arrangements . It was noted that the facility was closed on Friday 30th November at 2pm , commented that it may not have been open that day , also closed at 3.30 on Sunday 2nd Dec . 2. Road Speed lights are now causing consternation at both ends of Tayport . 3. Parking in Castle Street – Is it possible to have parking properly marked . Lots of space is wasted due to ad hoc parking . 4. Snagging at Karen Dewar garden - faults on fence and stonework have been noticed - design is good . 5.
