<p>Fife Councillor's Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The process to extend the Cemetery has begun . Discussion will take place with the owner of adjacent land . 2. The work to improve the Harbour area has begun . Some diversion of the Cycle Path and walkway will be necessary 3. Shrubs have been illegally removed from the Cowgate , they will be replaced . 4. Potholes on the StMichaels road will be repaired . 5. Provision of a new school in the Taybridgehead area – position clarified . Due to falling School rolls in the area , a new School in St Andrews is the priority of Fife Council at this time . 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Give way marking at single speed hump in Elizabeth St is causing a problem 2. The toddler swings have not yet been provided in the new Play Park 3. Drainage repair at Drumoig Golf Club work sheds on St Michaels Rd has not been completed , as the blockage at the sheds still exists . 4. Sand should be removed from the road beyond the Law Cottages . 5. Is the Scott Crescent one way system in operation yet – as there is no signage 6. As the recycling bins are full and overflowing – do we need more . 7. What is the optimum height of speed bumps as there appear to be discrepancies 8. The speed light controls at the entries to Tayport are still not working 9. Can the damaged coping stone at the top of Whitenhill be repaired .
