Tayport and Tentsmuir Alcohol Free Zone should be finalised in July/August . 4. Police are keeping a judicial eye on the new Traveller's site .

<p>Fife Councillor's Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Castle Road is to be resurfaced , Tay Street is a lower priority at present . 2. The Textile recycling Bank at Shanwell Road is not run by Fife Council . 3. Mill Lane Industrial Site is showing signs of contamination , but not to a dangerous level . 4. A meeting on 12 June will comment on the Data Protection Act as it affects Community Councils . 5. Mr T Gray will meet with the Road's engineer to look at the blockage near the Drumoig sheds . 6. Council members were asked to think of projects locally where funding could be made available , footpath at the pond on the common , footpath at the lay-by Newport Road , clearing path from West Lights to shore were suggested , others to Councillor Taylor , please . 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Could the water running continuously out from the building site on Albert Street be investigated – is it from a spring . 2. Please look at the requirement for the 2 containers at the harbour , which are unsightly . 3. There is a need to cut back tree branches which are obscuring Warning signs and flashing speed warning lights , which still need adjusting .
