Victoria Road to Reform Street to be closed for 1 day for essential maintenance 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Could the bridge on Coffin Walk be repaired . 2. The footpath at the Lay-by by the WWtW has not yet been reinstated . 3. Request for some of the £40million allocated for care homes to be directed to Tayport for a residence here . 4. A broken branch on a tree in the Council garden requires attention . 5. Who or what is the Tayport Kidney Patient Association ? 6. Can the grass be cut at the Sandyhill play area 7. As the grass bank at the WWtW is becoming very overgrown and untidy , can we find out who is responsible for its maintenance . 8. The harbour toilets appear to be closed at normal opening times – can this be investigated . 9. The housing site in Ogilvy Place sold by Fife Council has become very unsightly can this be looked into . 10. As the quality of the fencing at the new play park is poor could a proper fence be erected . 11. Can a programme to clear the grass and weed from the pond be started . 12. 2 Lampposts at Jubilee Buildings are badly corroded and need attention . 13.
