<p>Police:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Percentage of calls to Tayport has decreased there were 14 during the last accounting period . 2. Speed cameras have been in use on Albert Street – with some success . Other areas , such as Cupar Road were suggested . 	
<p>Harbour Development: Phase 2: Presentation by Theresa Hughes and Gill Baldwin :</p> <p>Plans were shown of proposals , all were acceptable other than the siting of the recycling bins , the proposed site was unsuitable for nearby residences . Counter proposals made included leaving on present site with better screening or dig out the bank to the east of the Bell Rock . The plans will be on display in the entrance to the Burgh chambers during Library Opening Times – with a box and forms for comment and feedback from Tayport residents . This will be advertised throughout the town .</p>

<p>Fife Councillors Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Opening times of Toilets at Tayport Harbour is proving to be a problem . 2. Signs at Bridge Access have been removed - some Commercial ones are the real problem . 3. North East Fife Rotary would like to provide a permanent tree for lighting up at Christmas – either on the previous site or included in the planting of the Harbour area 4. The removal of a condom cost the Council i.e. US – £76.00 	

Questions for Fife Council:

1. A letter of enquiry as to the reduction of TCC Grant has not received a reply .
2. Flooding on the road at the Drumoig Greenkeepers shed area is still occurring .
3. Has a date been set for the resurfacing of Castle Road ?
4. The signs at the roadside for Drumoig Hotel are intrusive , are they legal?
5. Community Council request assurance that the roads and pavements leading to the Tayport Surgery would be gritted this winter .
6. Dangerous pothole in Cross Street near to the junction with Ogilvy Street
7. Could a waste bin be situated inside the new play area at the Common
8. Could a safety barrier be included on Coffin Walk at the entry to Cupar Road
9. Community Council expressed disappointment at the way everything had been left after the Office closure .No way of accessing public information leaflets , carousel , which could have been used , left in locked office , other information , booklets etc. left behind the door entry .
10. Can the Town clock chimes be started up again
11. Could a later bus be introduced for Ninewells visiting
12. There is a report of sludge in the harbour possibly coming from the old Treatment works at Harbour Rd
13. Line of sight is obstructed by overgrown hedges at Forgan Road where it joins the St Andrews road and at Inverdovat Road at the junction with Cupar Road .
