<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Can the fence around the housebuilding at Downiemount be made more secure and straightened as it is causing a hazard . 2. A NO DOGS sign , a seat and a bin are needed at the news playpark and the chips beneath the conical swing need refreshed . If hedging is to be replaced at this park , can it be inside the fence . 3. Could Fife Council look into extending the pavement railing at the Nursery 4. Is it possible that the Gas problem in Nelson Street was caused by vibration due to the Speed Humps . 5. When will the one way system at Scott Crescent come into force . 6. Path up from Reform Street at the top of the steps is very overgrown on the left . 7. Rose bushes at 66/68 Ogilvy Street are overgrown on to the pavement and require cutting back .
