<p>Fife Councillors Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Speed Bumps opposite 32 Nelson Street are to be removed . 2. Castle Road is to be resurfaced in 2009. 3. Lighting in Shanwell Road and Links Crescent is to be improved under plans by Fife Transportation Group . 4. A new Planning Application has to be lodged for the wall at Comely Bank , Albert Street , Tayport 5. Rotary wish to plant a live tree for Christmas on the grassy bank beside the Bell Rock Public House , Fife Council have given permission – lighting arrangements to be finalised with a donation to defray costs if required . 6. Councillor Taylor is looking for suggestions for the local initiative budget , Limited Criteria . 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Can the ownership of the bank at the WWtW be determined . 2. There is water seepage on to Scotsraig Drive , possibly from a broken pipe or joint , which requires attention . 3. Could something be done to upgrade the footpath from Spearshill Road to Scotsraig Drive area , under the ' Safer Route to School' initiative . 4. Previously reported , there is a large depression in the pavement at the entrance to the Old Manse in Queen Street , filling with rainwater . 5. A broken sign indicating Young Court needs repair . 6. Traffic signs are being covered by overgrown trees , e.g. at the Car Park opposite the Tennis Courts .
