2. Could the path of the water seepage onto the road beside the Bus Shelter on the Newport Road be identified and cleared .
3. Has any decision been made about the alternative to the speed bumps in Nelson Street which are to be removed .
4. There has been a build up of ice on the B946 caused by water running onto the road .
