<p>Police:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A very satisfactory report on this area was given . 2. A new shift pattern for local police will allow more coverage at Schools . 	
<p>Fife Council and General Correspondence:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ferryport Festival Committee have asked for a donation of £500.00 .Decision to be made at the next meeting . 2. The Newsletter from the new Community Hospital and Health Centre in St Andrews shows services and staff moving in from the end of June 2009 . 3. Discussion of the new Evening Appointment system at Tayport and Newport Medical Practices . 4. Beautiful Fife Campaign replaces the Best Kept Town and Village competition , we are asked to apply in the appropriate category based on population . 5. The consultation period for comments on the St Andrews and East Fife Local Plan environmental report has been extended until 6th March . 	
<p>Planning:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Planning permission for the land to the North of Scotsraig Drive has been given to Kingdom Housing by the Reporter . The conditions for this development made by the Reporter were discussed by the Community Council . 	

<p>Fife Councillors Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An approach for more land from Zara Takeaway in Elisabeth Street has been refused 2. Dates of Direct Debit Payments of Council Tax have been changed to the 1st of each Month . 3. The wall repair on the Newport Road was started as money was available for this work . 4. The lighting on the Esplanade is being renewed this month . 5. Although the signs at Drumoig are on Private land , their position is being reviewed . 6. The barrier outside of Tayport Nursery School will be extended . 7. Fife Council is looking for an action plan by Community Councils , all members are asked to look at projects , help can be sought from our Locality Manager . 8. There is to be a Public Enquiry into the access into Newport and Inverdovat from the Dual Carriageway . Interested parties are asked to register comments . 9. Any problems with the road closure at Mill Lane have been ironed out . 	
<p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It is agreed that the number of potholes has increased due to inclement weather , but those at the Tay Bridge access and at the entrance to Northfield farm are particularly bad and previously reported are the depressions at the Old manse and at the corner of the Speed Hump before entering Maitland Street . 2. Would it be possible to have a handrail on the bottom half of Victoria Road to junction with Castle Terrace . 3. Is it feasible to either landscape the ground at Golf Crescent or make into a parking area .
