High incidence of Dog Fouling referred to – the Police confirm that this is an offence in a Public place – notices to this effect are displayed throughout the area . Question from Tom Gray about policy on the Tay Road Bridge to speeding vehicles while the 30mph restrictions are in force . It would appear the that the speed limit is not being enforced , written reply would be appreciated . 	
<p>Fife Council and General Correspondence:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> St Andrews and East Fife Local Plan – To be published in Autumn of this year for consultation , Public Enquiry may follow in 2010 . Fife Licensing Board Applications for Premises Licences – No Objections . Crown Estate Scotland Bulletin – referred to Bruce Davidson Fife Elderly Forum Executive – There is one based at Servite House , Queen Street , Tayport . Community Council meetings must be open to the Public , including developers . 	
<p>Planning:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Rear extension at 56 Harbour Road , Tayport – No Objections . 	Secretary.
<p>Fife Councillor's Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The sign for Victoria Road should be sited at the William Street end . There is a plan being developed for the problem parking area at Golf Crescent There is a pilot scheme of Monthly Bin Collection being operated in the West Fife area , but it is emphasised that it is only a trial scheme. Community Justice are looking at schemes for offenders – cleaning up the Nature Trail in Newport/Wormit has been proposed . 	

<p>5. The lack of wireless connections for the IT Classes at the Dolphin Centre is Being dealt with by Alix Sutherland .</p> <p>6. New lighting is being provided on the Esplanade .</p> <p>7. The hole in the pavement at the Old Manse is not a priority , yet .</p> <p>Questions for Fife Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why are there so many streets blocked off unnecessarily while Gas Works proceed along Mill Lane/Cowgate . 2. There is a problem with parking on Craig Road as Gas works are overdue in this area . 3. Could additional play equipment be found for the play area at the Common . 4. It is suggested that a Community Justice project could be the clearing and cleaning of the Abertay Works site making it secure and safe . 5. Proposed town regeneration monies could be used to marry up Castle Street and the Harbour area , giving focus to Tayport centre . 	
<p>A.O.C.B.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The footpath at the WWtW will have to wait for additional funding . 2. There will be a Public Enquiry in the Blyth Hall on May 19th and 20th with reference to the accesses to Newport and farms from the Dual Carriageway . 3. Tayport School are running a poster competition publicising the Dog Fouling Problem . 4. Mr B Davidson will continue contact with the Community Trust .
