Tayport childrens Playgroup have been given permission to use an area within the grounds of the Burgh Chambers for a garden project , possibly using tubs or raised beds . The lack of response from the Fife Council Legal Dept. on the question of the inappropriate signage at Drumoig is causing concern and anger . 4. Could the condition of Coffin Walk be improved as in wet weather it is dangerous 5. Attention should be paid to the trees at the WwTW ,which are not fulfilling their promise . 6. Concern was again raised over the need for resurfacing in Tay Street and Broad Street . How much has Fife Council paid out in compensation for damage to cars because of Speed Bumps/ Bad Roads . 7. At the foot of Castle Road , the new surface is sliding and forming a ridge . 8. Can the water level of the Pond on the common be better regulated . 9.
