Noted by Fife Councillor .</p> <p>From the Public Gallery concern was expressed about any further development at the Caravan Park . Mr Baillie allayed any fears by stating that if at any time in the future this were to happen , a full Public Consultation would take place .</p> <p>The erosion along the foreshore is being monitored by Fife Council .</p>	
<p>Fife Councillor's Report:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Notice Board – should be lockable and sited on the Queen Street side of the Gregory Hall . 2. The old lamp standards are to be properly stored for future use in Tayport . 3. One way system in Scott Crescent is now set up and will be in use shortly 4. Entry into Celebrating Fife passed to Ferryport Festival committee . 5. The proposed Harbour opening will not now take place until phase 3 is complete 	

Questions for Fife Council:

1. Could the Yew tree in the Auld Kirk yard be trimmed.
2. Bollards at Mason's Lane have been cut down to a dangerous level .
Can they be reinstated or can they be removed and the area be utilised for parking
3. Conditions were applied to the planning of the wall at 43 Comely Bank , Albert Street .
Are these being met .
4. Can pavement construction outside of the Co-op in Castle St. be altered to provide more street space
5. There is a need for replenishment of wood chips at the Common playpark .
6. Since the street cleaning programme has been amended , it seems that at times there is far more rubbish not being picked up . Could a more regular and comprehensive cleaning programme be set up .

Cllr . Ron Caird reported on Madras School progress . A further site at the University has been identified , Langlands B , allowing the possibility of more shared facilities with the University . The Kilrymont site would be put on the market and if not sold within 3 years the process of de-listing would begin .
