Certificate will be on display in the Post Office . Information Pack re Digital Changeover in 2010 – to be placed in Library . Scottish Health Council Newsletter – reviewed Hospital and Maternity Services Newsletter – distributed Leuchars pharmacy appeal forwarded for decision . All conditions passed and conforming at 43 Albert Street. Pavement in Castle Street will remain as it is . Wood chips are still to be replaced at Common Playpark .

Castle Street parking – is it possible to do a preliminary plan of marked spaces to see if space could be used more efficiently ? 3. Are all conditions attached to the development at Scotsraig Drive being met and Dumper trucks are causing congestion , can they go off road ? 4. Can Library events be better advertised ? 5. Pond water levels at Common are still very erratic . 6. Is there any progress on the possible closure of Station Brae .
