Presentation to Youth Projects:

“Heather Whyte is proposing to fly to Ghana in August for 1 year with a Charity called Project Trust which aims to help improve the lives of children in different countries by teaching , working in Social Care or Coaching on Outward Bound Courses . Heather is to teach at a school in Ghana .As part of the experience she is required to raise £6300 to fund the year .Heather has so far raised £4000 through holding quiz nights etc “.

“Angus Kennovin and Jack Gaffney are proposing to take up a World Challenge . This group is a provider of life changing school expeditions to develop important life skills such as teamwork and leadership. This excursion takes in charity work , an exploratory hike and a small section of free time in Sri Lanka .In doing so this will allow them to get first hand experience working with people in developing countries , Each must raise £4000 and are organising or taking part in bake sales , coffee mornings and part time jobs Roughly £500 each has been raised so far” .

All three were presented with cheques for £50 towards their fund raising and good wishes on their journeys .
